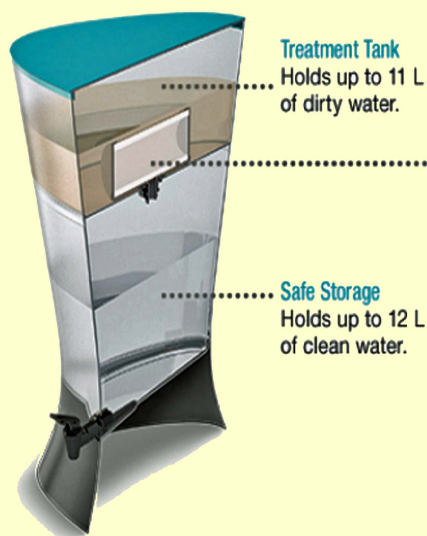

# Randy Budd on Terminal Ballistics



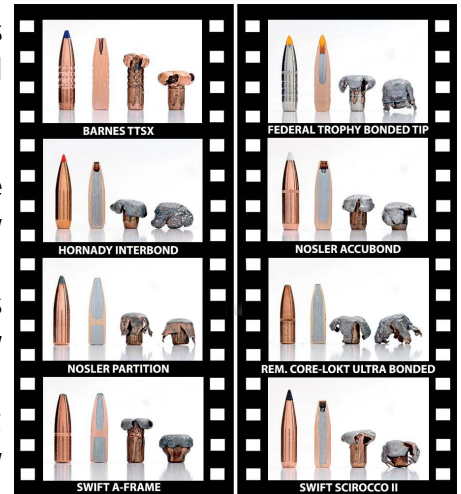
My brother and fellow Rotarian Randy Budd gave an informative program at yesterday's weekly Woodbury Rotary Lunch Club meeting. Randy, an avid hunter and fisherman spoken to the club about a Terminal Ballistics, which is by definition of Wikepedja "the study of the behavior and effects of a projectile when it hits its target and transfers its energy to the target. Bullet design and the velocity of impact determine the effectiveness of its impact". Randy was conscientious of his topic in respect to the recent shootings that have occurred.

He focused his talk in relation to big game hunting and discussed the many various bullets used and the difference of hydraulic and hydrostatic shock.

He also discussed the Weatherby magnum, created by Roy Weatherby and which was the first magnum hunting cartridge created in 1944. One of the hallmarks of a great big game bullet is its ability to offer good terminal performance from very close range to long range. Almost any bullet can be made to expand at long range, but the thin jackets and soft cores that promote such expansion don't support bullet integrity when impact distances are close and velocities extremely high. Conversely, it's not that difficult to produce a bullet that will hold together at close-range, high-impact velocities, but the heavy jackets, harder lead-alloy cores and bonding processes used to create such bullets can inhibit expansion when distances stretch and velocities drop.
