

Pennsville Rotarians Made Major Contributions to Library

Sponsored by Salem Rotary Club, Pennsville held its first organizational meeting March 31, 1950 under the leadership of Salem's Past District Governor Thomas Wingate (1938-39) with 13 men in attendance. The club was chartered May 22, 1950 with Rev. David A. Wilson Jr. installed as president of a club which had 22 charter members. Of the 22, four are still active in the club.

Among the many highlights of Pennsville Rotary's strong civic commitment through the years was a public library for Pennsville Township which represented the club's Rotary International Golden Anniversary project. The building was begun in 1954 and was completed and dedicated on May 26, 1957 at an appraised value of \$35,000. Pennsville Rotarians, contributed a significant portion of the labor.

Other Pennsville Rotary projects have included a Municipal Park Bandstand and Junior Rotarians Program. Pennsville also was the sponsor of Woodstown Rotary.
