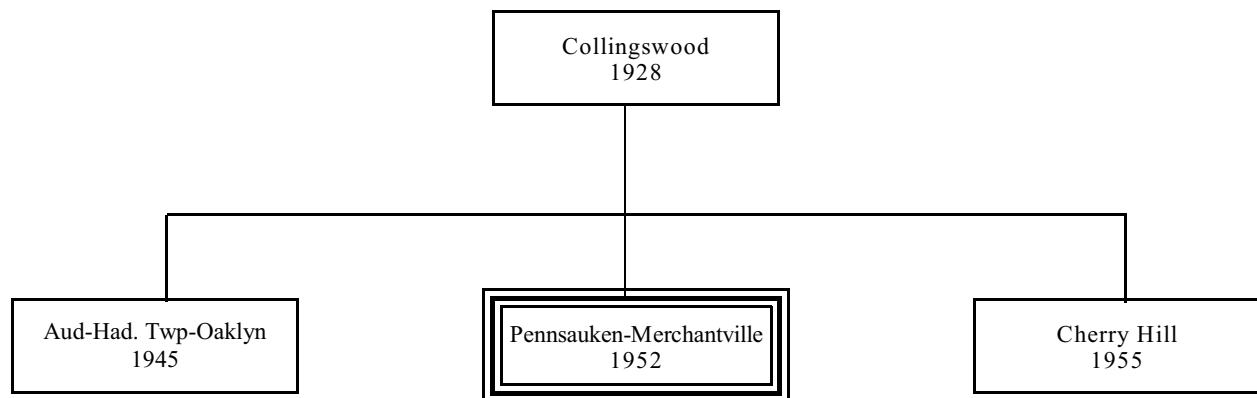

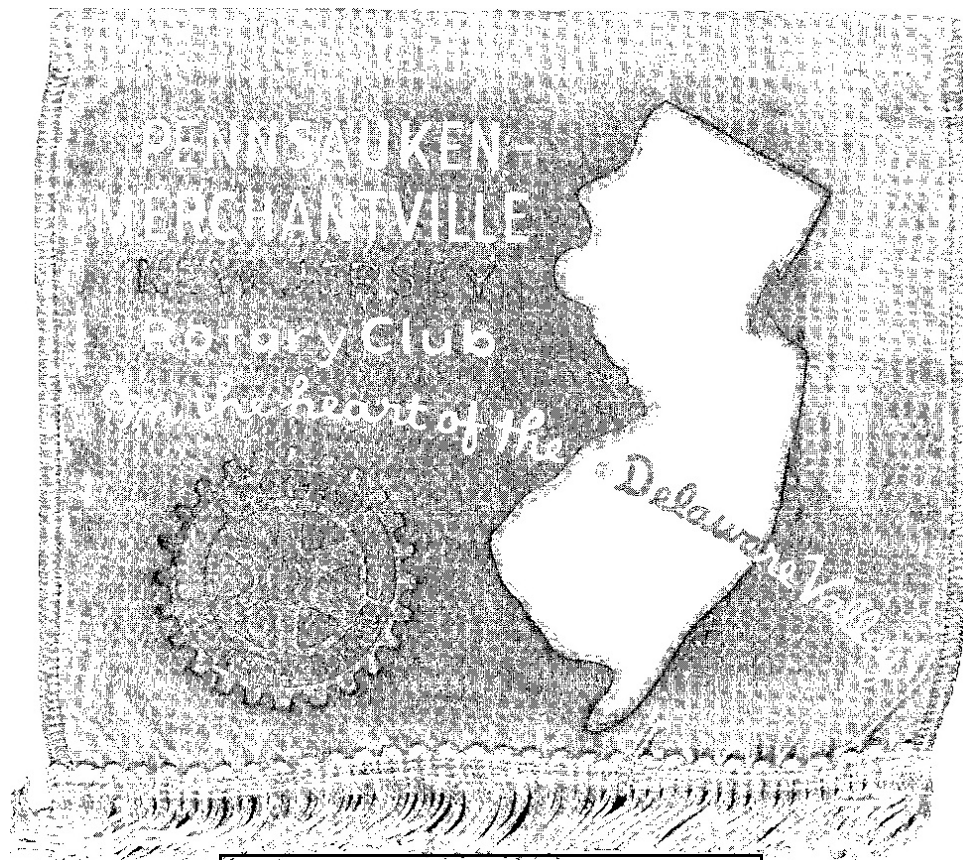
More Than Half of Pennsauken-Merchantville PHFs
