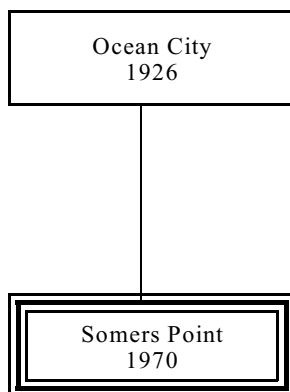

Sponsored by Ocean City Rotary with its special representative Frank McTear, the Rotary Club of Somers Point was chartered March 17, 1972.

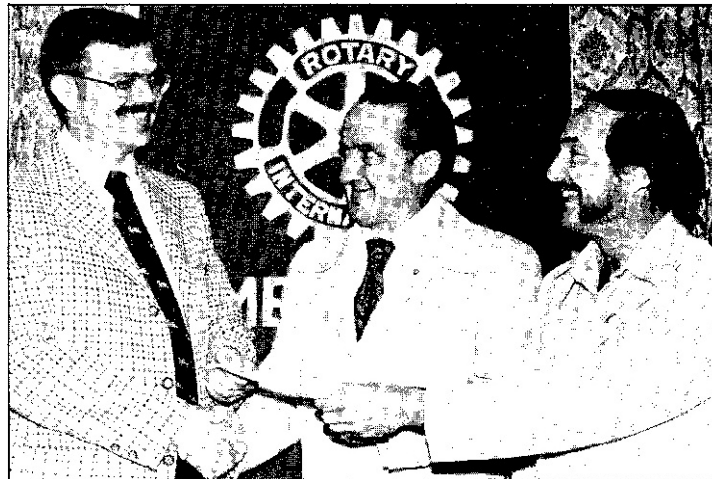
The club had 23 charter members including first president Henry Wimberg.
